CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

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Public High Schools - Health Education - Gambling Dangers and Addiction

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education, on or before a certain date, to develop a certain program of education on the dangers of gambling and 4 5 gambling addiction; requiring the program to be coordinated with other State 6 agencies responsible for gambling addiction education and control; requiring 7 authorizing a county board of education to, beginning in a certain school year, require each public middle and high school in the county to include instruction on 8 9 gambling dangers and addiction in certain grades, beginning in a certain school year 10 and annually thereafter once during a certain period of time; authorizing the State 11 Board of Education to adopt regulations to implement this Act; requiring the 12 Department, on or before a certain date, to report to the Governor and the General Assembly on the county boards that required instruction on the dangers of gambling 13 and gambling addiction, including information on the program of education that each 14 county board used; and generally relating to education on the dangers of gambling 15 and gambling addiction for students in public high schools. 16

- 18 (E) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2023, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT
- 19 TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1257 OF THE STATE
- 20 GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE COUNTY BOARDS THAT
- 21 REQUIRED INSTRUCTION ON THE DANGERS OF GAMBLING AND GAMBLING
- 22 ADDICTION, INCLUDING INFORMATION ON THE PROGRAM OF EDUCATION THAT
- 23 EACH COUNTY BOARD USED.
