## Chapter 515 of the Acts of 2016

SECTION 14. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That § 3–704, § 3–707, and § 3–708 of the Correctional Services Article, as enacted by Section 2 of this Act, shall be construed prospectively to apply only to [inmates that are sentenced] THE PORTION OF AN INMATE'S SENTENCE THAT IS ORIGINALLY IMPOSED, MODIFIED, OR ORDERED TO BE SERVED FOR A VIOLATION OF PROBATION on or after October 1, 2017.

# 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be construed20 to:
