- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Transportation, in conjunction with the 5 Department of the Environment, to develop a plan to replace trees that are removed 6 during construction of the Purple Line; requiring the Department of Transportation 7 to consult with certain entities and individuals in developing the plan; requiring the 8 plan to provide for the replacement of trees in certain communities and prioritize the 9 initial replacement of trees in certain communities; authorizing the replacement of trees on certain types of property; requiring the Department of Transportation, in 10 11 collaboration with the Department of the Environment, the Department of Natural 12 Resources, and certain other State agencies, to identify available sources of funding 13 for replacing trees in accordance with this Act; defining certain terms; and generally 14 relating to replacing trees removed during construction of the Purple Line.
