1 AN ACT concerning

Baltimore–Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport – Security Screening Checkpoint – Charitable Donations

FOR the purpose of requiring the Executive Director of the Maryland Aviation
Administration to place donation boxes at the entrance to each security screening
checkpoint at the Baltimore–Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport;
requiring that money deposited in the donation boxes be appropriated for the benefit
of a certain program and be used to supplement, but not supplant, certain other
funds; defining certain terms; and generally relating to donation boxes and the
Baltimore–Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

19 **5–413.1.**

20 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 21 INDICATED.

(2) "DONATION BOX" MEANS A CLEARLY MARKED RECEPTACLE FOR THE CHARITABLE DONATION OF MONEY BY THE PUBLIC.

1 (3) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE RENTAL ALLOWANCE PROGRAM 2 ESTABLISHED UNDER § 4–1403 OF THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT 3 ARTICLE.

4 (B) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL PLACE AND MAINTAIN DONATION 5 BOXES AT THE ENTRANCE TO EACH SECURITY SCREENING CHECKPOINT AT THE 6 BALTIMORE–WASHINGTON INTERNATIONAL THURGOOD MARSHALL AIRPORT.

7 (C) THE MONEY DEPOSITED IN THE DONATION BOXES REQUIRED UNDER 8 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE:

9 (1) APPROPRIATED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PROGRAM; AND

10 (2) USED TO SUPPLEMENT, BUT NOT SUPPLANT, ANY OTHER 11 FUNDING AVAILABLE FOR THE PROGRAM.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2019.
