# **Baltimore County – Sunday Hunting**

- FOR the purpose of repealing a certain restriction on Sunday deer hunting in Baltimore
  County; authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to allow a person in
  Baltimore County to hunt any game bird or game mammal, except migratory game
  birds and wetland game birds, on a Sunday on certain land during the open season
  for that game bird or game mammal; making conforming changes; and generally
  relating to Sunday hunting in Baltimore County.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2), (3), (4), (6), (7), (8), [and] (9), AND
  (10) of this subsection, a person may not hunt any game bird or mammal on Sundays.
- 20 (2) The following persons may hunt the specified game birds and mammals 21 on Sundays:
- (i) A person using State certified raptors to hunt game birds ormammals during open season;
