authorizing the Governor to include an annual appropriation to the Program in the
State budget; requiring the Department to implement and administer the Program;
requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations; defining a certain term; and
generally relating to the Grant Program for Workforce Skills Assessment.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 Article Labor and Employment
- 17 **11–605.**

18 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE GRANT PROGRAM FOR 19 WORKFORCE SKILLS ASSESSMENT.

20 (B) THERE IS A GRANT PROGRAM FOR WORKFORCE SKILLS ASSESSMENT 21 IN THE DEPARTMENT.

22 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL 23 ASSISTANCE TO AN EMPLOYER FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF ASSESSMENTS THAT

1 MEASURE WORKPLACE OR JOB-RELATED SKILLS OF EMPLOYEES WHO ARE STATE 2 RESIDENTS.

3 (D) THE GOVERNOR MAY INCLUDE IN THE STATE BUDGET AN ANNUAL 4 APPROPRIATION TO THE PROGRAM.

5 (E) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IMPLEMENT AND ADMINISTER THE 6 PROGRAM IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.

7 (F) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS 8 SECTION, INCLUDING REGULATIONS TO:

9 (1) DEVELOP REQUIREMENTS FOR GRANT APPLICATIONS;

10(2)DEVELOP A PROCESS FOR REVIEWING GRANT APPLICATIONS AND11AWARDING GRANTS TO ELIGIBLE EMPLOYERS; AND

12(3) DETERMINE A CAP FOR THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF A GRANT THAT13AN ELIGIBLE EMPLOYER MAY RECEIVE EACH YEAR.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 October 1, 2020.
