THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IS A MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY POLICE; AND 2122 2. THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER RESIDES IN A 23POLITICAL SUBDIVISION IN WHICH THE CRIME RATE EXCEEDS THE STATE'S CRIME 24RATE. 25On or before September 1, 2016, and every 3 years thereafter, the Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission shall certify to the Comptroller the 26 political subdivisions in which the crime rate exceeds the State's crime rate. 27
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2019, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after December 31, 2018.
