- 16 (A) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A person
- 17 may not directly or indirectly advertise for or solicit business in this State for any medical
- 18 laboratory, regardless of location, from anyone except a physician, hospital, medical
- 19 laboratory, clinic, clinical installation, or other medical care facility.
- 20 (B) A PERSON MAY DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY ADVERTISE FOR OR SOLICIT
- 21 BUSINESS IN THE STATE FOR A LABORATORY TEST OR PROCEDURE ORDERED BY A
