29 30	(XV) THE GREYWATER USE IS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ANY APPLICABLE LOCAL LAWS OR REGULATIONS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

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1 October 1, 2018.
