## **Building Lifelong Library Learners Act**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a public library from charging a minor an overdue fine for 4 overdue library materials or fee for an overdue library book on a minor's library 5 materials; prohibiting a public library from charging a minor a replacement fine or fee until a certain date; requiring a public library to cancel or return a certain 6 7 replacement fine or fee if a book is returned; prohibiting a public library from 8 collecting any outstanding fine or fee fees incurred by a minor for an overdue book 9 on or before certain dates; overdue library materials after a certain date; requiring 10 certain library boards to adopt certain regulations; altering the calculation of certain funding for the State Library Research Center and each county public library system 11 12 for certain fiscal years; requiring the Governor to include a certain amount in the 13 annual operating or capital budget submission for county capital projects; defining a certain term certain terms; providing for the application of this Act; and generally 14 15 relating to public libraries in the State.
