- 24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 25 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health – General

- 2 (a) (1) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the Secretary shall provide, on request, any person authorized by regulations adopted under this subtitle with a certified or abridged copy of a birth, death, or fetal death certificate registered under this subtitle or of the certificate of a marriage performed after June 1, 1951.
- 6 (2) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section AND SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (H) OF THIS SECTION, a local health department or the Motor Vehicle Administration may:
- 9 (i) Access electronically from the Department a certified or abridged 10 copy of a birth certificate registered under this subtitle; and
- 11 (ii) On request, provide any person authorized by regulations 12 adopted under this subtitle with a certified or abridged copy of a birth certificate registered 13 under this subtitle.
- 14 (H) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT SECURITY 15 PROTOCOLS AND OTHER PROTECTIONS TO:
- 16 (I) ENSURE A PERSON WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION IS 17 PROHIBITED FROM ACCESSING ANY VITAL RECORDS; AND
- 18 (II) MINIMIZE THE DISCLOSURE OF AND THE ACCESS TO
 19 MEDICALLY SENSITIVE INFORMATION FROM THE VITAL RECORDS DATABASE BY
 20 EMPLOYEES NOT EMPLOYED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 21 (2) THE SECURITY PROTOCOLS AND OTHER PROTECTIONS 22 DEVELOPED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE AN 23 AUDITABLE RECORD OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 24 (I) THE DATE AND TIME A CERTIFIED OR ABRIDGED COPY OF A 25 BIRTH CERTIFICATE WAS PRINTED;
- 26 (II) THE IDENTIFICATION OF THE EMPLOYEE WHO PRINTED 27 THE CERTIFIED OR ABRIDGED COPY OF THE BIRTH CERTIFICATE; AND
- 28 (III) A SCANNED COPY OF THE GOVERNMENT–ISSUED 29 IDENTIFICATION CARD OF THE EMPLOYEE WHO PRINTED THE CERTIFIED OR 30 ABRIDGED COPY OF THE BIRTH CERTIFICATE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2019.
