3 FOR the purpose of requiring that a certain number of years before the expiration of a 4 certain term of a video lottery operation license the licensee file a certain notice with $\mathbf{5}$ the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission; authorizing a video lottery 6 operation licensee, within a certain number of years after filing a certain notice, to 7 file an application to renew a certain license that includes a certain payment; 8 providing for the term of a renewed license; requiring the Commission to renew a 9 certain license unless the Commission makes a certain finding; requiring the Commission to establish a certain application process; requiring the Commission, 1011 under certain circumstances, to provide a licensee an opportunity for a certain 12hearing; and generally relating to the renewal of video lottery operation licenses.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(a) The initial term of a video lottery operation license is 15 years from the dateon which the video lottery facility is issued the license by the Commission.

3 (c) Two years before the expiration of the INITIAL 15-YEAR LICENSE term OR 4 A RENEWAL TERM of a video lottery operation license, the licensee shall file with the 5 Commission a notice of intent to [reapply for] APPLY FOR RENEWAL OF the license under 6 this subtitle.

7 (d) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO THE FIRST RENEWAL OF A VIDEO
8 LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSE FOLLOWING THE INITIAL 15-YEAR TERM AND EACH
9 SUBSEQUENT RENEWAL OF THE LICENSE.

10(2) A RENEWAL OF A VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSE IS FOR A11TERM OF 10 YEARS.

(3) Within 1 year [of the end of the initial 15-year license term] AFTER
FILING A NOTICE OF INTENT UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, a video lottery
operation licensee may [reapply for a] FILE AN APPLICATION TO RENEW A VIDEO
LOTTERY OPERATION license [that has a license term of 10 years and a] THAT INCLUDES
THE PAYMENT OF THE license RENEWAL fee to be established by statute.

17 (4) ON PROPER APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF A VIDEO LOTTERY 18 OPERATION LICENSE AND PAYMENT OF THE LICENSE RENEWAL FEE, THE 19 COMMISSION SHALL RENEW THE LICENSE UNLESS THE COMMISSION FINDS THAT 20 THE LICENSEE IS NO LONGER QUALIFIED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE TO HOLD A 21 LICENSE.

(5) THE COMMISSION SHALL ESTABLISH AN APPLICATION PROCESS
 TO RENEW A VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSE.

(6) BEFORE DENYING AN APPLICATION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION,
 THE COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE THE VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSEE AN
 OPPORTUNITY FOR A HEARING.

(e) If a licensee has its license revoked or otherwise surrenders the license, thevideo lottery operation license reverts to the State.

29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 October 1, 2020.
