Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission – Use of Handcuffs – Body Attachments Policy

FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission,
on or before a certain date, to develop certain written policies to provide guidance to
law enforcement agencies on the appropriate use of handcuffs when taking a person
into custody on a body attachment; requiring each law enforcement agency, on or
before a certain date, to adopt and implement certain written policies developed by
the Commission; and generally relating to the use of handcuffs by law enforcement
officers.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 (A) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2020, THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING 21 AND STANDARDS COMMISSION SHALL DEVELOP A WRITTEN POLICY ON THE 22 APPROPRIATE USE OF HANDCUFFS WHEN TAKING A PERSON INTO CUSTODY ON A 23 BODY ATTACHMENT AS GUIDANCE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES IN THE 24 STATE.

1 (B) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2021, EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IN 2 THE STATE SHALL ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT THE WRITTEN POLICY DEVELOPED BY 3 THE MARYLAND POLICE TRAINING AND STANDARDS COMMISSION ON THE 4 APPROPRIATE USE OF HANDCUFFS BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS WHEN TAKING 5 A PERSON INTO CUSTODY ON A BODY ATTACHMENT.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 7 1, 2020.
