Washington County – Code of Public Local Laws – Legalization

FOR the purpose of legalizing the 2019 edition of the Code of Public Local Laws of
Washington County, being Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland,
published under the direction of the Board of County Commissioners of Washington
County; making provisions for the publication, sale, and distribution of the Code of
Public Local Laws of Washington County; and generally relating to the legalization
of the Code of Public Local Laws of Washington County.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. 10 That the 2019 edition of the Code of Public Local Laws of Washington County, being Article 11 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, published under the direction of the Board 12of County Commissioners of Washington County is legalized. Any supplement to the 2019 13Code of Public Local Laws of Washington County that may be published under the direction 14of the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, is legalized. The Code shall 15contain all the public local laws relating to Washington County following the 2019 regular 16session of the General Assembly of Maryland. The Code shall be deemed and taken in all 17the courts of the State and by all public officials of the State and of its several political 18 subdivisions to be evidence of the public local laws of Washington County in existence at 19the time of the compilation.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Board of County 21 Commissioners of Washington County may make an appropriation to provide for the 22 publication of this Code and the Board may provide for its sale and distribution.

23 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July24 1, 2019.
