FOR the purpose of authorizing county boards to establish innovative regional schools subject to certain requirements <u>and approval</u>; providing that innovative regional schools are eligible for certain public school construction funding; requiring the Interagency Commission on School Construction to adopt certain regulations; exempting innovative regional schools from certain provisions of law; <u>requiring a</u> certain collective bargaining agreement to govern working conditions in innovative

regional schools, subject to a certain exception; requiring innovative regional schools to comply with certain regulations and provisions of law; defining a certain term;

and generally relating to establishing innovative regional schools.
