Health Occupations - Physical Therapists and Physical Therapist Assistants -Qualifications

- FOR the purpose of establishing a certain educational qualification for an applicant for a 4 5 physical therapist assistant license who was educated in limited physical therapy 6 outside of any state; altering certain educational qualifications for certain applicants 7 for physical therapy licenses or physical therapist assistant licenses who were 8 educated in any state; making technical and conforming changes; and generally 9 relating to qualifications for physical therapy licenses and physical therapist assistant licenses. 10
