

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 13 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Health - General 15 16 13 - 305.The Commission consists of 12 members appointed by the Governor. 17 (a) (1) Of the 12 Commission members: 18 (2)1 shall be an individual from the Renal Administrators 19 (i) 20 Association: 213 shall be individuals who are laypersons to the field of medicine; (ii) 223 shall be individuals appointed at the discretion of the Governor (iii)

31 (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is 32 appointed and qualifies.

- 1 (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the 2 rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- 3 (5) A member who serves 2 consecutive full 4—year terms may not be 4 reappointed for 4 years after completion of those terms.
- 5 (6) (i) If a vacancy occurs, the Governor promptly shall appoint a successor who will serve until the term expires.
- 7 (ii) The successor may be reappointed for a full term.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 9 1, 2019.
