# FOR the purpose of repealing a certain provision of law that prohibits certain members of the State Commission on Kidney Disease from having any direct ownership in renal dialysis or kidney transplant centers that do business in the State; altering the number of names required to be on a certain list; and generally relating to the membership of the State Commission on Kidney Disease.

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1 (2) The terms of the members are staggered as required by the terms 2 provided for members of the Commission on July 1, 1982. The terms of one fourth of those 3 members end each year.

6 (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the 7 rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

- 8 (5) A member who serves 2 consecutive full 4-year terms may not be 9 reappointed for 4 years after completion of those terms.
