A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Higher Education – Policy on Student Concerns About Athletic Programs and Activities

4 FOR the purpose of requiring each institution of higher education to develop and adopt a $\mathbf{5}$ certain policy that meets certain requirements on or before a certain date; 6 authorizing an institution of higher education to make changes to the policy under 7 certain circumstances; requiring each institution of higher education to post the 8 policy and any changes to the policy on the institution's website; requiring each institution of higher education to ensure that each student who participates in the 9 institution's athletic programs or activities has a copy of the policy and any changes 10 11 to the policy; requiring each institution of higher education to submit to the 12Maryland Higher Education Commission and certain committees of the General 13 Assembly the policy and any changes to the policy by a certain date; requiring each 14institution of higher education to submit to the Commission on or before a certain 15date each year the number of students who shared concerns under the policy; 16 requiring the Commission to report a summary of certain submissions to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date each year; providing 17for the application of this Act; and generally relating to a policy on student concerns 1819about athletic programs and activities.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 SUBTITLE 16. POLICY ON STUDENT CONCERNS ABOUT ATHLETIC PROGRAMS AND 2 ACTIVITIES.

4 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER 5 EDUCATION THAT DOES NOT HAVE AN ATHLETIC PROGRAM OR ADMINISTER 6 ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES.

7 (B) (1) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2019, EACH INSTITUTION OF HIGHER 8 EDUCATION SHALL DEVELOP AND ADOPT A WRITTEN POLICY FOR RECEIVING AND 9 ADDRESSING STUDENT CONCERNS ABOUT THE INSTITUTION'S ATHLETIC PROGRAMS 10 AND ACTIVITIES THAT INCLUDES:

11 (I) A PROCESS THROUGH WHICH STUDENTS CAN SHARE 12 CONCERNS ABOUT THE INSTITUTION'S ATHLETIC PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES WITH 13 THE INSTITUTION'S ADMINISTRATION, INCLUDING SENIOR OFFICIALS WITHIN THE 14 ADMINISTRATION WHO ARE NOT DIRECTLY INVOLVED WITH THE MANAGEMENT OF 15 ATHLETIC PROGRAMS OR ACTIVITIES;

16 (II) AN OPTION FOR STUDENTS TO SUBMIT THEIR CONCERNS 17 CONFIDENTIALLY; AND

18(III) A PROHIBITION ON RETALIATING OR DISCRIMINATING19AGAINST STUDENTS WHO SHARE THEIR CONCERNS UNDER THE POLICY.

20(2)AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION MAY MAKE CHANGES TO21THE POLICY IF THE CHANGES MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

22 (C) EACH INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL:

23(1) POST THE POLICY AND ANY CHANGES TO THE POLICY ON THE24INSTITUTION'S WEBSITE; AND

25 (2) ENSURE THAT EACH STUDENT WHO PARTICIPATES IN THE 26 INSTITUTION'S ATHLETIC PROGRAMS OR ACTIVITIES HAS A COPY OF THE POLICY 27 AND ANY CHANGES TO THE POLICY.

28 (D) EACH INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL SUBMIT TO THE 29 COMMISSION AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT 30 ARTICLE, THE SENATE EDUCATION, HEALTH, AND ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS 31 COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE:

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1 (1) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2019, THE WRITTEN POLICY 2 ADOPTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (B)(1) OF THIS SECTION; AND

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(2) ANY CHANGES TO THE POLICY.

4 (E) (1) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2020, AND EACH JULY 1 THEREAFTER, 5 EACH INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL REPORT TO THE COMMISSION ON 6 THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS WHO SHARED CONCERNS UNDER THE INSTITUTION'S 7 POLICY DURING THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR.

8 (2) ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 1, 2020, AND EACH AUGUST 1 9 THEREAFTER, THE COMMISSION SHALL REPORT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF 10 THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE SENATE EDUCATION, HEALTH, AND 11 ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS 12 COMMITTEE A SUMMARY OF THE SUBMISSIONS UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 13 SUBSECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2019.
