1 AN ACT concerning

Maryland Military Veterans

- FOR the purpose of designating certain individuals as Maryland Military Veterans; establishing that a Maryland Military Veteran is not entitled to certain benefits, rights, or privileges applicable to certain veterans; establishing that a Maryland Military Veteran designation is separate from the entitlements due to certain veterans; requiring the Governor to annually commemorate Maryland Military Veterans on a certain day; authorizing the use of the State flag in certain burial services; and generally relating to Maryland Military Veterans.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (A) AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE DESIGNATED AS A MARYLAND MILITARY

- 22 (2) WAS DISCHARGED OR RELEASED UNDER CONDITIONS OTHER

- 5 (2) THE DESIGNATION OF A MARYLAND MILITARY VETERAN SHALL
- 6 BE SEPARATE FROM, AND NOT SUPPLANT, THE ENTITLEMENTS DUE TO A VETERAN
- 7 DETERMINED ELIGIBLE UNDER 38 U.S.C. § 101.
- 8 (C) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL COMMEMORATE MARYLAND
- 9 MILITARY VETERANS ON MARYLAND DAY.

- THE STATE FLAG MAY BE USED IN THE BURIAL SERVICE OF A DECEASED
- 12 MARYLAND MILITARY VETERAN.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
