A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Family Law – Child Custody – Visitation Rights of Noncustodial Parents**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the court, in a child custody proceeding between the
4 parents of a child, to make arrangements for visitation with the child in a
5 certain manner under certain circumstances; and generally relating to child
6 custody and visitation.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Family Law**

15 **9–109.**

16 **SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF §§ 9–101, 9–101.1, AND 9–101.2 OF THIS**
17 **SUBTITLE, IN A CHILD CUSTODY PROCEEDING BETWEEN THE PARENTS OF A**
18 **CHILD, IF THE COURT AWARDS PHYSICAL CUSTODY TO ONE PARENT WITH**
19 **VISITATION RIGHTS TO THE OTHER PARENT, THE COURT SHALL MAKE**
20 **ARRANGEMENTS FOR VISITATION WITH THE CHILD IN THE FOLLOWING**
21 **MANNER:**

22 **(1) (I) THE NONCUSTODIAL PARENT SHALL HAVE VISITATION**
23 **WITH THE CHILD EVERY OTHER WEEKEND FROM FRIDAY NIGHT THROUGH**
24 **MONDAY MORNING;**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(II) THE NONCUSTODIAL PARENT SHALL HAVE VISITATION**
2 **WITH THE CHILD FOR 4 WEEKS DURING THE SUMMER; AND**

3 **(III) THE NONCUSTODIAL PARENT SHALL HAVE VISITATION**
4 **WITH THE CHILD ON ALTERNATE HOLIDAYS; OR**

5 **(2) THE NONCUSTODIAL PARENT SHALL HAVE VISITATION WITH**
6 **THE CHILD FOR APPROXIMATELY THE SAME AMOUNT OF TIME AS DESCRIBED IN**
7 **ITEM (1) OF THIS SECTION ACCORDING TO A SCHEDULE DETERMINED BY THE**
8 **COURT.**

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2011.
