### A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

#### 2 Labor and Employment – Grant Program for Workforce Skills Assessment

- FOR the purpose of establishing the Grant Program for Workforce Skills Assessment in the
  Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation; providing for the purpose of the
  Program; authorizing the Governor to include an annual appropriation to the
  Program in the State budget; requiring the Department to implement and
  administer the Program; requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations;
  defining a certain term; and generally relating to the Grant Program for Workforce
  Skills Assessment.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### Article – Labor and Employment

- 18 **11–603.**
- 19 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE GRANT PROGRAM FOR 20 WORKFORCE SKILLS ASSESSMENT.
- 21 (B) THERE IS A GRANT PROGRAM FOR WORKFORCE SKILLS ASSESSMENT 22 IN THE DEPARTMENT.
- 23 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL

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1 ASSISTANCE TO AN EMPLOYER FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF ASSESSMENTS THAT 2 MEASURE WORKPLACE OR JOB-RELATED SKILLS OF EMPLOYEES WHO ARE STATE 3 RESIDENTS.

4 (D) THE GOVERNOR MAY INCLUDE IN THE STATE BUDGET AN ANNUAL 5 APPROPRIATION TO THE PROGRAM.

6 (E) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IMPLEMENT AND ADMINISTER THE 7 PROGRAM IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.

8 (F) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS 9 SECTION, INCLUDING REGULATIONS TO:

10 (1) DEVELOP REQUIREMENTS FOR GRANT APPLICATIONS;

11(2)DEVELOP A PROCESS FOR REVIEWING GRANT APPLICATIONS AND12AWARDING GRANTS TO ELIGIBLE EMPLOYERS; AND

# 13(3) DETERMINE A CAP FOR THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF A GRANT THAT14AN ELIGIBLE EMPLOYER MAY RECEIVE EACH YEAR.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2019.
