An Act to Address Late Medical Billing by Limiting Hospital Billing to One Year

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1728 is enacted to read:
3	§1728. Time limit for billing
4 5 6 7 8	A bill for a service provided by a hospital licensed under chapter 405 must be issued to the patient or the legal guardian of the patient who received the service within one year of the provision of the service. If a bill is issued by a hospital in violation of this section, the patient or the legal guardian of the patient who received the service is not obligated to pay the bill.
9	SUMMARY
10 11	This bill requires a hospital to issue a bill within one year of providing a service or the patient or guardian of the patient who received the service is not obligated to pay the bill.
