## An Act to Provide Transparency in Public School Curricula

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §1001, sub-§23 is enacted to read:
3 4	23. Transparency of curricula and libraries. Each school board shall publish by October 1st of each school year for review by parents the following:
5	A. Teaching materials;
6	B. A list of required textbooks;
7	C. Course syllabi, lesson plans and tests; and
8	D. A list of books available in the library and the intended reading age of those books.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill requires each school board to publish curriculum and library-related materials
11	by October 1st of each school year for review by parents.
