1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §10911 is enacted to read: 2 §10911. Maine Rural Economy Future Development Program 3 4 1. Program established. The Maine Rural Economy Future Development Program, referred to in this section as "the program," is established within the university to promote 5 future business development in rural Maine through the creation of programs that provide 6 course offerings on the economy of rural Maine. 7 8 2. Campus participation; required. As part of the program, the University of Maine at Fort Kent, the University of Maine at Presque Isle, the University of Maine at Machias 9 10 and the University of Maine at Farmington shall each create and offer a program that provides a comprehensive study of the rural economy of Maine and that promotes the 11 partnering of students with businesses in rural Maine. 12 13 3. Program criteria. The program must: 14 A. Provide each student with compensation, health care, a housing voucher and student loan forgiveness in exchange for work at the respective campus; and 15 16 B. On a biennial basis, allow for up to 3 students from each campus required to offer a program under subsection 2 to be selected to work for 2 years on rural economic 17 18 growth once the students graduate. 19 Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and 20 allocations are made. 21 UNIVERSITY OF MAINE SYSTEM, BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE 22 Maine Rural Economy Future Development Program N351 23 Initiative: Provides ongoing annual funds of \$500,000 each to the University of Maine at Fort Kent, the University of Maine at Presque Isle, the University of Maine at Machias and 24 the University of Maine at Farmington to establish and implement the Maine Rural 25 26 Economy Future Development Program established in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 27 20-A, section 10911. Funds appropriated to this program do not lapse but must be carried forward into the next fiscal year to be used only for the purpose for which the funds were 28 29 provided. 30 **GENERAL FUND** 2021-22 2022-23 31 All Other \$2,000,000 \$2,000,000 32 33 \$2,000,000 \$2,000,000 GENERAL FUND TOTAL 34 **SUMMARY** 35 This bill establishes the Maine Rural Economy Future Development Program within 36 the University of Maine System to promote future business development in rural Maine by 37 providing course offerings on the economy of rural Maine. The bill requires the University of Maine at Fort Kent, the University of Maine at Presque Isle, the University of Maine at 38 39 Machias and the University of Maine at Farmington to each create and offer a program that 40 provides a comprehensive study of the rural economy of Maine and that promotes the partnering of students with businesses in rural Maine. The bill specifies that the program 41

1 must include provisions that, on a biennial basis, allow for up to 3 students from each 2 campus required to implement the program to be selected to work for 2 years on rural 3 economic growth once they graduate and that provide each student with compensation, 4 health care, a housing voucher and student loan forgiveness in exchange for work at the 5 respective campus. The bill also provides General Fund appropriations of \$2,000,000 per 6 year, with each of the 4 campuses required to establish and implement the program 7 receiving \$500,000 annually.
