2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1552, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:
3 4 5	<u>1-A. Proximity to schools.</u> The department may not issue a new or renewed retail tobacco license to a retailer located within 1,000 feet of a school in existence at the time the application for the new or renewed license is made.
6 7 8 9	For the purposes of this subsection, "school" includes a public school, as defined in Title 20-A, section 1, subsection 24; a private school, as defined in Title 20-A, section 1, subsection 22; a public preschool program, as defined in Title 20-A, section 1, subsection 23-A; and any other educational facility that serves children from prekindergarten to grade 12.
11 12	Distance must be measured from the main entrance of the retailer's premises to the main entrance of the school by the ordinary course of travel.
13	SUMMARY
14 15	This bill prohibits the Department of Health and Human Services from issuing a new or renewed retail tobacco license to a retailer operating within 1,000 feet of a school.
