1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §6601-A, as enacted by PL 2017, c. 238, §1, is amended to
read:

4 §6601-A. National School Lunch Program; Internet-based school meal applications

5 The department by July 1st annually shall make information available to public 6 schools regarding Internet-based applications for eligible students for free or 7 reduced-price meals under the National School Lunch Program under 7 Code of Federal 8 Regulations, Part 210. A public school may make an Internet-based application available 9 for school meal applications. If a public school implements an Internet-based application 10 process under this section, the public school shall make available a paper application for 11 school meals to any student, parent or legal guardian who requests one.

13 This bill requires the Department of Education on an annual basis to provide 14 information to public schools regarding Internet-based applications for free or reduced-15 price meals under the National School Lunch Program.
