Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
PART A
Sec. A-1. 24 MRSA §2317-B, sub-§22, as amended by PL 2019, c. 605, §3, is further amended to read:
22. Title 24-A, section 4320-M. Coverage for abortion services, Title 24-A, section 4320-M; and
Sec. A-2. 24 MRSA §2317-B, sub-§23, as enacted by PL 2019, c. 605, §4, is amended to read:
23. Title 24-A, sections 2766-A and 2847-W. The prohibition on a dental benefit waiting period for persons under 19 years of age, Title 24-A, sections 2766-A and 2847-W-: and
Sec. A-3. 24 MRSA §2317-B, sub-§24 is enacted to read:
24. Title 24-A, sections 2743-C and 2834-E. Coverage for newly born male infant circumcision, Title 24-A, sections 2743-C and 2834-E.
Sec. A-4. 24-A MRSA §2743-C is enacted to read:
§2743-C. Coverage for newly born male infant circumcision
An insurer that issues individual contracts providing maternity benefits, including benefits for childbirth, shall provide coverage for circumcision of a newly born male infant.
Sec. A-5. 24-A MRSA §2834-E is enacted to read:
§2834-E. Coverage for newly born male infant circumcision
An insurer that issues group contracts and certificates providing maternity benefits, including benefits for childbirth, shall provide coverage for circumcision of a newly born male infant.
Sec. A-6. 24-A MRSA §4234-G is enacted to read:
§4234-G. Coverage for newly born male infant circumcision
A health maintenance organization that issues individual and group contracts providing maternity benefits, including benefits for childbirth, shall provide coverage for circumcision for a newly born male infant.
Sec. A-7. Application. The requirements of this Part apply to all policies, contracts and certificates executed, delivered, issued for delivery, continued or renewed in this State on or after January 1, 2024. For purposes of this Part, all policies, contracts and certificates are deemed to be renewed no later than the next yearly anniversary of the contract date.
PART B
Sec. B-1. 22 MRSA §3174-KKK is enacted to read:
§3174-KKK. Reimbursement for costs of circumcision
Beginning January 1, 2024, the department shall provide reimbursement under the MaineCare program for the costs of circumcision for a newly born male infant.

2 3	Part A of this bill requires health insurance coverage for newly born male infant circumcision. The requirements apply beginning on January 1, 2024.
4 5	Part B of this bill requires the MaineCare program to provide reimbursement for the costs of newly born male infant circumcision beginning January 1, 2024.
