1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1501-C is enacted to read:
3	§1501-C. Permanent license for out-of-state licensees
4	Notwithstanding section 1504, subsection 1, the board may issue a permanent license
5	to an applicant who holds an active license to practice funeral service in another state the
6	license requirements of which are substantially similar to the license requirements under
7	this chapter and board rules.

9	This bill allows the State Board of Funeral Service to issue a permanent license to
10	engage in the funeral service profession and operate a funeral establishment to an
11	applicant who holds an active license to practice funeral service in another state the
12	license requirements of which are substantially similar to the license requirements in
