1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to health; appropriating money for advance care planning on end-of-life
1.3 care choices.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. APPROPRIATION FOR ADVANCE CARE PLANNING.

1.6 \$800,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$800,000 in fiscal year 2021 are appropriated from the
1.7 general fund to the commissioner of health to award a grant to a statewide advance care
1.8 planning resource organization that has expertise in convening and coordinating
1.9 community-based strategies to encourage individuals, families, caregivers, and health care
1.10 providers to begin conversations regarding end-of-life care choices that express an
1.11 individual's health care values and preferences and are based on informed health care
1.12 decisions. \$500,000 is added to the base appropriation beginning in fiscal year 2022 and
1.13 continuing in each fiscal year thereafter for grants for advance care planning.
