1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. PORT DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE.
1.6	Subdivision 1. <b>Appropriation.</b> \$10,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.7	<u>fund to the commissioner of transportation for purposes of the port development assistance</u>
1.8	program under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 457A. Any improvements made with the
1.9	proceeds of these grants must be publicly owned.
1.10	Subd 2 Dand cale. To anaride the manary annuanisted in subdivision 1 from the
1.10	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the
1.11	bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
