1.10	(b) A district must receive school readiness aid equal to:
1.11	(1) the number of four-year-old children in the district on October 1 for the previous
1.12	school year times the ratio of 50 percent of the total school readiness aid for that year to the

1.15	(2) the number of pupils enrolled in the school district from families eligible for the free
