1.9	need analysis. For dependent students, the assigned family responsibility is 84 79 percent
1.10	of the parental contribution. For independent students with dependents other than a spouse,
1.11	the assigned family responsibility is 76 71 percent of the student contribution. For

1.13	responsibility is 40 35 percent of the student contribution.
