A public school may seek an exemption to subdivision 2 by 1.8 submitting a request in writing to all 11 federally recognized Tribal Nations in Minnesota 1.9 and to the Tribal Nations Education Committee by September 1, 2023. The exemption is 1.10 denied if any of the 11 Tribal Nations or the Tribal Nations Education Committee oppose 1.11 the exemption by December 15, 2023. A public school whose request for an exemption is 1.12 denied must comply with subdivision 2 by September 1, 2025 is exempt from the prohibition 1.13 in subdivision 2 if an American Indian Tribe located in the same county as the public school 1.14 1.15 does not object to the use of an American Indian mascot.
