1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; providing notice of state contribution for local
1.3 projects; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 16A.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. [16A.865] NOTICE OF STATE CONTRIBUTION.

1.6 Subdivision 1. Notice required. When practicable, a recipient of a grant of state bond
1.7 proceeds for a capital project or a direct recipient of an appropriation from any state funds
1.8 for a capital project must prominently display a notice on the property stating that the project
1.9 was funded with state taxes collected statewide.

1.10 Subd. 2. Content of notice. The notice must display the logo provided by the
1.11 commissioner under subdivision 5, and identify the project as "funded with a grant of state
1.12 money from taxes collected statewide." The notice may include a brief name for the project
1.13 and may specify the proportion of the funding from state money compared to money from
1.14 nonstate sources. The notice may include logos, seals, or marks of other contributors to the
1.15 cost of the project.

1.16 Subd. 3. Water infrastructure project. For a drinking water or wastewater infrastructure
1.17 project, the notice required under this section must be included on city utility billing
1.18 statements in all formats that the city provides billing statements to customers.

1.19 Subd. 4. Performance venues. For performance venue projects, the notice must be
1.20 included in programs and on the venue's website where performances are advertised, in
1.21 addition to on a sign posted at the venue.

2.1 Subd. 5. **Logo.** The commissioner must develop a logo for use on signs required under
2.2 subdivision 1.

2.3 Subd. 6. **Sign templates.** The commissioner must post on its website downloadable,
2.4 print-ready PDF files of sign templates that meet the requirements of subdivision 1.

2.5 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment and
2.6 applies to projects receiving a grant from an appropriation enacted after January 1, 2024.
