1.8	Subd. 6. Allocation and use of grant awards. (a) The board must allocate grant
1.9	awards only for the following transit purposes:
1.10	(i) capital improvements to transitways, including, but not limited to, commuter rail
1.11	rolling stock, light rail vehicles, and transitway buses;
1.12	(ii) capital costs for park-and-ride facilities, as defined in section 174.256,
1.13	subdivision 2;
1.14	(iii) feasibility studies, planning, alternatives analyses, environmental studies,
1.15	engineering, property acquisition for transitway purposes, and construction of transitways;

1.17	(iv) operating assistance for transitways.
1.18	(b) The joint powers board must annually award grants to each minimum guarantee
1.19	county in an amount no less than the amount of sales tax revenue collected within that
