1.7	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 462A.05, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.9	Subd. 42. Rent assistance program. The agency may administer the rent assistance
1.10	program established in section 462A.2095.
1.11	Sec. 2. [462A.2095] RENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.
1.12	Subdivision 1. Program established. The state rent assistance account is established
1.13	as a separate account in the housing development fund. Money in the account is appropriated
1.14	to the agency for grants to local housing authorities for the purposes specified in this section.
1.15 1.16	Subd. 2. Definitions. (a) For purposes of this section, the following terms have the meanings given them.
1.17	(b) "Eligible person" means an individual or family with an annual income of up to 50
1.18	percent of the area median income as determined by the United States Department of Housing
1.19	and Urban Development, adjusted for family size, that is paying more than 30 percent of
1.20	the individual's or family's annual income on rent. Eligibility is determined at the time an
1.21	individual or family first receives rent assistance under this section. Eligible person does

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not incl	ude an individual or family receiving federal tenant-based or project-based assistance
under S	ection 8 of the United States Housing Act of 1937, as amended.
<u>(c) "</u>	Local housing authority" means:
<u>(1)</u> a	housing and redevelopment authority or other local government agency or authority
that adn	ninisters federal tenant-based or project-based assistance under Section 8 of the
<u>United</u>	States Housing Act of 1937, as amended;
<u>(2)</u> a	tribal government or tribal housing authority; or
(3) i	f the local housing authority, tribal government, or tribal housing authority declines
to admi	nister the program established in this section, a nongovernmental organization
<u>determi</u>	ned by the agency to have the capacity to administer the program.
Sub	d. 3. Grants to local housing authorities. (a) The agency may make grants to local
housing	authorities to provide rent assistance to eligible persons. To the extent practicable,
the ager	ncy must make grants in each county in proportion to the number of persons eligible
for assis	stance in each county according to the most recent American Community Survey
of the U	Inited States Census Bureau.
<u>(b)</u> 7	The local housing authority may use its existing procedures to administer the rent
assistan	ce program or may develop alternative procedures best suited to the service area in
which i	t administers rent assistance. The agency must approve a local housing authority's
procedu	ires.
Sub	d. 4. Amount of rent assistance. A local housing authority may provide tenant-based
or proje	ct-based rent assistance to eligible persons in amounts equal to the difference between
30 perce	ent of household income and the rent charged, plus an allowance for utilities if not
include	d in rent. A local housing authority may not provide assistance that is more than the
differen	ce between 30 percent of household income and 110 percent of the applicable fair
market	rent for the location and family size of the eligible person as determined by the
United	States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
Sub	d. 5. Administrative fee. A local housing authority may use up to the lesser of \$
or p	ercent of a grant each year for administrative costs.

fund to	the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency for transfer to the housing development
