TRUNK HIGHWAY MOWING OR HAYING; PERMIT MORATORIUM. 1.6 (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), the commissioner of transportation must 1.7 implement a moratorium until April 30, <del>2019</del> 2020, on enforcing permits under Minnesota 1.8 Statutes, sections 160.232 and 160.2715, or any other Minnesota statute or administrative 1.9 rule, to mow or bale hay in the right-of-way of a trunk highway. 1.10 (b) This section applies regardless of the date of any permit issuance. This section does 1.11 not apply to a right-of-way adjacent to land under the jurisdiction of the state or a political 1.12 1.13 subdivision.
