1.6	Section 1. [120B.219] CHILD ABUSE AWARENESS POSTERS.
1.7	(a) The commissioner shall, in consultation with local, state, and federal agencies and
1.8	nonprofit organizations, create a poster that notifies children of the appropriate number to
1.9	call to report child abuse or neglect. The poster shall:
1.10	(1) include a note that directs a child to dial 911 in case of emergency;
1.11	(2) include a phone number for the county's child protection services;
1.12	(3) be no smaller than 8-1/2 inches by 11 inches; and
1.13	(4) be produced in at least five languages other than English that are spoken in the state
1.14	as determined by the commissioner.
1.15	(b) The commissioner shall make all versions of the poster available to the public on
1.16	the department's Web site.
1.17	(c) A school district, charter school, and nonpublic school must post the
