1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to health; prohibiting therapies and procedures performed for the treatment

1.3 of gender dysphoria in minors; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,

1.4 chapter 145.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[145.4225] PROHIBITED TREATMENTS FOR GENDER DYSPHORIA**

1.7 **IN MINORS.**

1.8 (a) All licensed or regulated health care providers are prohibited from the following

1.9 when treating gender dysphoria in minors:

1.10 (1) performing or assisting with sex reassignment surgery or any other surgical procedures

1.11 that alters primary or secondary sexual characteristics; and

1.12 (2) prescribing, dispensing, or administering puberty blocking hormones or hormone

1.13 antagonist therapies.

1.14 (b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), a licensed or regulated health care provider may

1.15 continue the prescription, dispensation, or administration for puberty blocking hormones

1.16 or hormone antagonist therapies for a minor who is receiving such treatment prior to the

1.17 effective date of this act.

1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
