- (e) The board must receive a revised supervision plan within 30 days of any of the following changes:
- 4.10 (1) the supervisee has a new supervisor;
- 4.11 (2) the supervisee begins a new social work position;
- 4.12 (3) the scope or content of the supervisee's social work practice changes substantially;
- 4.13 (4) the number of practice or supervision hours changes substantially; or
- 4.14 (5) the type of supervision changes as supervision is described in section 148D.062.
  - (f) The board may revoke a licensee's provisional license for failure to submit a revised supervision plan as required in paragraph (e).
- (g) The board must approve the supervisor and the supervision plan.
