AN ACT

To amend chapter 338, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to emergency contraceptives.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 338, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 338.257, to read as follows:

3 **338.257. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no pharmacy licensed in this**
4 **state shall provide emergency contraceptives for over-the-counter sale. For purposes of**
5 **this section, the term “emergency contraceptive” shall mean any drug, device, or**
6 **interchangeable biological product approved by the Food and Drug Administration that**
7 **prevents pregnancy after intercourse.**
