AN ACT

To amend chapter 217, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to parole eligibility.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 217, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 217.698, to read as follows:

217.698. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any person convicted of a crime that was committed prior to such person attaining the age of twenty-one and who was sentenced on or after January 1, 1976, shall be eligible for parole after:

- 4 (1) Serving one-third of his or her sentence that is calculated to thirty years or less;
 5 or
- 6 (2) Serving a minimum of fifteen years for any sentence of imprisonment which is 7 calculated to be more than thirty years, including a sentence of life without parole.
