AN ACT

To repeal sections 300.411 and 304.678, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to the distance to be maintained when overtaking a bicycle, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

- Section A. Sections 300.411 and 304.678, RSMo, are repealed and two new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 300.411 and 304.678, to read as follows:
 - 300.411. The operator of a motor vehicle overtaking a bicycle proceeding in the same
- 2 direction on the roadway, as defined in section 300.010, or on the shoulder of the roadway,
- 3 shall leave a safe distance, but in no case less than three feet clearance, when passing the
- 4 bicycle, and shall maintain clearance until safely past the overtaken bicycle.
 - 304.678. 1. The operator of a motor vehicle overtaking a bicycle proceeding in the same
- 2 direction on the roadway, as defined in section 300.010, or on the shoulder of the roadway,
- 3 shall leave a safe distance, but in no case less than three feet clearance, when passing the
- 4 bicycle, and shall maintain clearance until safely past the overtaken bicycle.
- 5 2. Any person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of an infraction unless 6 [an accident is involved in which case it shall be a class C misdemeanor]:
 - (1) The person intentionally violates the provisions of this section; or
 - (2) An accident is involved.
