AN ACT

To amend chapter 590, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to investigations of officer-involved incidents.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 590, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 590.513, to read as follows:

590.513. 1. If an officer-involved death occurs, the attorney general shall appoint
a special prosecutor to investigate the officer's actions regarding such death. The special
prosecutor shall conduct an investigation and determine if charges are appropriate.

2. If severe officer misconduct is alleged, the attorney general shall determine the
validity of the allegation and, if severe officer misconduct likely occurred, appoint a special
prosecutor to investigate the officer's actions regarding such incident. The special
prosecutor shall conduct an investigation and determine if charges are appropriate.

8 3. The attorney general shall have discretion to appoint any attorney licensed in this state as a special prosecutor. Such special prosecutor shall possess all powers of a 9 10 prosecuting attorney or assistant attorney general in exercising his or her prosecutorial duties. If such special prosecutor is a prosecutor of a county or city not within a county, 11 12 he or she shall receive no additional compensation for serving as special prosecutor. If the 13 special prosecutor is not a prosecutor of a county or city not within a county, he or she 14 shall receive a reasonable fee for serving as such special prosecutor. Such fee shall be fixed by the judge appointing the attorney and shall be paid from the funds of the office of the 15 16 prosecutor of the jurisdiction in which the complaint or charges are filed.

4. For the purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

18 (1) "Officer-involved death", the death of an individual that occurred while the 19 individual was in police custody or that results directly from an action or omission by a law 20 enforcement officer while the officer is on duty or while off duty but performing activities 21 that are within the scope of his or her law enforcement duties;

(2) "Severe officer misconduct", an incident in which an individual is injured as
a result of an action or omission by a law enforcement officer while the officer is on duty
or while off duty but performing activities that are within the scope of his or her law
