## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 173, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to video game competitions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 173, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 173.2600, to read as follows:

173.2600. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, student participants in video game competitions shall not be considered student athletes and video game competitions shall not be considered sporting or athletic events for any purpose.

- 2. No public institution of higher education shall implement any rules or policies that subject video game competitors to institutional or athletic organizational regulations relating to prizes, winnings, or compensation of student athletes.
- 3. The provisions of this section shall not prohibit any public institution of higher education from awarding scholarships based on video gaming abilities.
