## AN ACT

To repeal section 479.090, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to discovery procedures for certain municipal ordinance violations.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 479.090, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 479.090, to read as follows:

479.090. **1.** All prosecutions for the violation of municipal ordinances shall be instituted by information and may be based upon a complaint. **Except as provided in subsection 2 of this section,** proceedings shall be in accordance with the supreme court rules governing practice and procedure in proceedings before municipal judges.

**2. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1 of this section, discovery procedures for a proceeding for a municipal ordinance violation in which confinement in jail is an authorized form of disposition shall be governed by supreme court rule 25.**
