AN ACT

To amend chapter 137, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to property tax assessments.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 137, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 137.386, to read as follows:

137.386. 1. An assessor of property in a first class county shall report all appeals which he or she receives to the board of equalization of his or her county.

- 2. If a board of equalization of a first class county receives a total of ten thousand or more appeals on the assessments of properties within the county for a given calendar year, including all appeals received directly by the board and any appeals reported to the board by an assessor, the board of equalization shall order an automatic reassessment of all properties within the county for which the board has received an appeal for that year.
- 3. Any reassessment, as described under subsection 2 of this section, shall be conducted by the assessor of property in the county and shall be completed in as timely of a manner as possible. All applicable provisions of this chapter shall apply to the reassessment.
