AN ACT

To repeal section 40.435, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to military complaints against a commanding officer.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 40.435, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu
2 thereof, to be known as section 40.435, to read as follows:

40.435. Any member of the state military forces who believes himself wronged by the
2 member's commanding officer, and who, upon due application to that commanding officer, is
3 refused redress, may complain to any superior commissioned officer, who shall forward the
4 complaint to the ~~governor or~~ adjutant general, who shall examine such complaint and take
5 proper measures for redressing the wrong.
