## AN ACT

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the designation of public holidays.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 9.220, to read as follows:

2 **9.220. October sixteenth of each year shall be known and designated as “Walt**  
3 **Disney - ‘A Day to Dream’ Day”.** The citizens of this state are encouraged to participate  
4 **in appropriate activities and events to commemorate the life and accomplishments of Walt**  
4 **Disney.**
